

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHOR

Submission Guidelines for Authors

To ensure a smooth submission process, authors are requested to adhere to the following criteria:

Originality - Manuscripts must be entirely original and previously unpublished in any journal, blog, or website.

Formatting - Papers must follow the IRJICT Manuscript format, using Times New Roman font for all text and headings.

File Specifications - Submissions must be written in English and provided exclusively in MS-Word (**.doc** or .docx) format.

Length & Authorship - Manuscripts are limited to a maximum of 10 pages (exceeding this requires revision) and may include up to 6 authors.

Review Process - All submissions undergo a double-blind peer review. Authors must integrate all reviewer feedback and suggestions before final publication.

Abstract Requirements- Ensure that relevant index terms or keywords are included within the abstract.

Acceptance & Copyright - Upon approval by the review committee, the Editor-in-Chief will issue a certificate of acceptance. Authors are then required to sign the IRJICT copyright transfer form.

Publication - Once the copyright form is received, the paper will be published, and the author will be notified.
